Language

- Ask questions and encourage me to ask them, too
- Read aloud to me

Toys and Equipment that Will Assist Me in My Development

- Area to walk and run
- Enjoy taking walks with adults
- Enjoy plenty of sensory experiences
- Dramatic play items, such as dress-up clothes, dolls, housekeeping equipment, dishes
- Low shelves with toys, such as small people, animals, doll houses, containers with small objects, measuring cups, and spoons
- Books with clear and simple pictures
